Noted important rules:

1. Cell phones or communication devices must be placed on "vibrate mode" while at the table during tournament play. The use of such device is strictly prohibited while at the table. Only listening devices will be allowed at the table.
 - You may step away from the table to use your phone.
 - Any use of a communication device at the table will result in an immediate one round penalty, (Uses Include)...
 - Texting or checking text messages, answering or making phone calls while at the table.
2. No flashing Cards, Intentional card flashing will incur a one round penalty. Any money in the pot is property of the pot and will not be returned to the player. The player may finish the hand in question and then be assessed the penalty
3. A player who exposes their hand called dead.
 - If a player exposes their hand prior to any betting the hand would be considered dead. The player would then be penalized one round.
 - If the player has placed a bet or raise and exposes their hand they are at a disadvantage. In this case their hand would not be considered dead, betting would still be open. Once the hand has been completed the penalty would be imposed.
4. Unprotected hands which are mucked will have no redress, and no money will be returned to the player.
5. It is the player's responsibility to know where they are in a hand and what action is taking place. A player who places an inadequate number of chips into the pot in turn when making a call will be held to the following guidelines.
 - None of the ill placed chips will be returned to the player. Any money in the pot becomes property of the pot and will not be returned to the player.
 - The players will have the option to call the remaining amount to complete the bet or fold.
6. Any player who directs profane or abusive language toward another player, dealer or Mohegan Sun staff member, will be given a minimum of a one round penalty on the first offence.
7. A non directed dropping of the (F) bomb will result in a warning on the first offence and a penalty thereafter.
8. Players must be present at the table and at their seat prior to all players being dealt a complete initial hand. Players not "at their seat" prior to the last initial card dealt will have their hand mucked immediately. In order to call "time" a players must be in their seat. "At your seat" is defined as being within reach or touch of your chair.
9. Bounty chips must remain on the table and in clear site at all times, failure to do so will incur a one round penalty.
 - Failure to produce a bounty chip which is missing may result in disqualification from the tournament.

*All Prize pools will contain 100% of the buy-in portion of the cost of the tournament.

**Mohegan Sun will withhold 3% of the prize pool for tournament staff

***Winners will be required to provide a valid form of government ID and a Social Security number to obtain his or her winnings. Prizes are non-transferable and will expire 120 days from the date won.
