RV/Camper Regulations

1: <u>Parking Area</u>. For an overnight stay, all RVs and campers **must** utilize the Trading Cove parking lot (or other designated area) and have a **valid** permit displayed in the RV/camper window (*This is to notify other personnel that your vehicle is catalogued with us*).

2: <u>Generators</u>. Generators are permitted, provided they do not disturb other guests.

3: <u>Transportation</u>. Currently, no shuttle service is provided for guests. A sidewalk is available to safely walk to the casino. It is adjacent to Sandy Desert Road, across from the Mohegan Tribal Public Safety building.

4: <u>Pets.</u> Pets are welcome, but for their safety, we require them to be on a leash or appropriate tether. Additionally, pets must be properly cared for (I.E., the owner providing food, water and a hospitable environment) during their stay.

5: <u>Grills.</u> Propane operated grills are allowed. By regulation, all other heat sources are not permitted.

6: <u>Patronage</u>. Patrons of the casino are welcome to stay in the RV parking area. However, storing or attempting to sell items, or vehicles of any type, is not permitted. <u>You must be on property</u> with your RV/Camper.

7: <u>ID and Registrations</u>. Guests requesting a permit must provide proper identification and valid registration for <u>all</u> vehicles that will be staying on site.

8: <u>Dumping.</u> Dumping of waste materials from any type of RV/camper is strictly **prohibited!** Please contact a local septic company for assistance.

Article XVI In accordance with, Section 5-411 through 419

It is prohibited for any person issued this permit to dispose of or dump any solid waste, including sanitary sewerage, grey water or wastewater of any type, into a parking lot catch basin connected to a storm drainage system or into any other drainage structure (i.e. yard drains) not equipped to handle such waste.

Violators are subject to civil prosecution, penalties and/or damages imposed by the Tribe not to exceed \$5,000 per violation per day, based on the severity of the violation and the effect on human health and the environment resulting from the violation.

The Tribe is authorized to recover any and all costs incurred to clean-up any solid waste, including sanitary wastes illegally dumped. In addition, the Tribe is authorized to recover any costs incurred from damages caused by violators to the land, surface water, storm water systems and any structures associated with these systems.

Note: Any violation may result in cancelling of your permit and removal from the property.
